

One line per medication, filled in once and corrected whenever something changes. This is the single worksheet most likely to help prevent a dangerous mistake, because medication lists are where different providers' information most often stops matching.

Bring this to every appointment where medication might change. A prescriber who can see the full list, including what other prescribers have ordered, is one of the more effective ways to catch an interaction before it happens.
